DMLK Parents and Guardians,

July 22nd, 2020

We are working diligently to prepare as best as possible for our school year during these constantly-changing times. We have some important information we need to communicate with you to ensure we are all on the same page. *Please note-Because our current situation is fluid, it is possible that the information on this letter could get modified at some point. We will do our best to communicate through autodialers, text, emails and social media.

Our first day of school is August 24th, and ALL STUDENTS will NOW start remote for the first quarter of the year through October 16th. The district will monitor the health data to plan for a gradual return to in-person instruction.

Our online registration window and the Annual Family Update (AFU) opened on Monday, July 27th. Please be sure to update you student's information via the DPS Parent Portal in order to register at DMLK. You can update your parent portal account at myportal@dpsk12.org and you can also learn more information about the Annual Family Update by visiting schoolchoice@dpsk12.org.

The AFU will give you the option to select 100% remote learning or to attend in-person at DMLK (which again, will begin remote until at least September 8). Please take your time before completing this document. Consider your options and weight them against the district and public health guidance prior to making a commitment. The commitment that you select will be your students placement for the entire first semester.

Remote Learning vs. In-Person Learning

Select Enroll in In-Person Learning or a Virtual Program for the Fall Semester. With the 2020-21 school year approaching, it's time for families to choose their preferred learning option for the fall semester in addition to the DMLK registration process.

Beginning July 27th, families will make a final selection and enroll in either in-person learning at DMLK, or a virtual program for each student. Visit www.dpsk12.org/coronavirus/return-2020 for more information about these two options. Please note the decision to officially enroll in either in-person learning or a virtual program is final through December 2020. If you choose a virtual program, your student will still keep their enrollment spot at the school they were expected to attend for the 2020-21 fall semester.

The fastest, most convenient way to officially enroll is through Annual Family Update, DPS' online registration process. As in past years, you also will be able to verify and update your household information during Annual Family Update. To take part in Annual Family Update, first make sure you have an active Parent Portal account at myportal.dpsk12.org. Then, sign in beginning July 27. The registration deadline for DMLK is August 7th. For more information on Annual Family Update, visit schoolchoice.dpsk12.org.

You will need to complete BOTH the DPS survey in addition to registering through our school below.

July 27th-August 7th- is the registration window for DMLK (Registration is ONLINE ONLY)

Concurrent Enrollment-From the Higher Education Initiatives Team) It has come to our attention you may have heard that all Concurrent/Dual Enrollment courses are starting on August 17 instead of on the district start date of August 24. This may not be accurate, depending on where the course is being taken. Please take a moment to read the information below to ensure your schools and students are aware of the correct start date for Concurrent/Dual Enrollment courses.

Start Date for Concurrent Enrollment

If the Concurrent/Dual Enrollment class is taught at your high school, the class will start on Monday, August 24 when the district starts.

If the Concurrent/Dual Enrollment class is taught on the college campus, a student must follow the college calendar and start when the college starts. College start dates vary so please check the college calendar.
